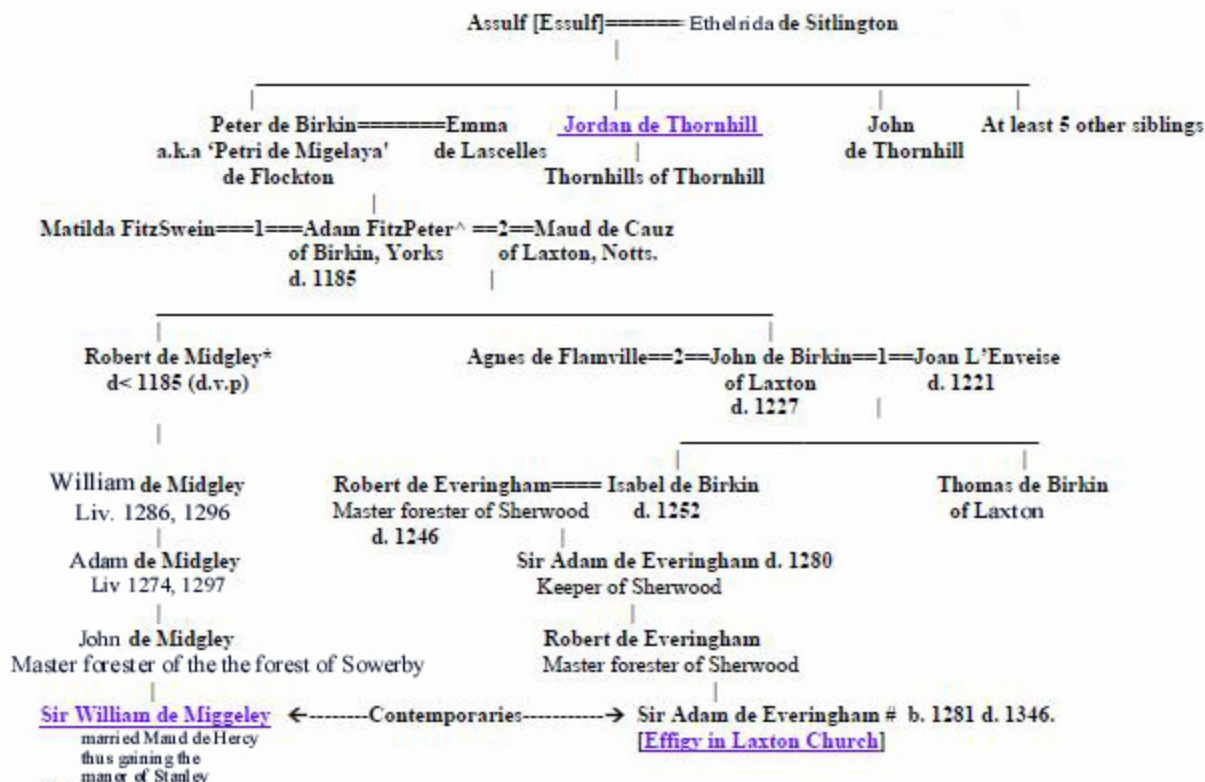


Interpolated genealogy of the early Midgley - Thornhill - Everingham families of Yorkshire

^ He was also called, or called himself: Adam de Birkin, de Falthwaite, de Flockton, de Middleton, de Midgley, de Sitlington, de Stainborough. He was granted a knights fee by Adam FitzSwein in Havercroft, Stainborough, Lepton, Mirfield, Sitlington and Flockton and held one knights fee from Henry de Laci of Pontefract. and a bovate at 'Little Midgley' near Wakefield.

*A.k.a. 'Roberto filio Ade filii Petri'. [*Chartulary of Pontefract.*]

In 1302-3 Adam held a carucate in Sitlington [Middlestown] and a half carucate in Flockton [Charles Travis, *Early Yorkshire Charters.* 1949, p.210.] Aids granted to King Edward I shows that Adam had 2 carucates in Flockton. [*Kirkby's Inquest* p. 292.] He held 'Chylington' i.e. Sitlington. [*Nomina villarum* p. 352.]
